### Shankhpushpi capsules

Convolvulus pluricaulis is an indigenous plant commonly mentioned in Ayurveda, as a rasayana which is mainly advocated for use in mental stimulation and rejuvenation therapy. Convolvulus pluricaulis is a prostrate, spreading, perennial, wild herb commonly found on sandy or rocky ground under xerophytic conditions in northern India. The drug is used as antiepileptic. It is used alone or is administered along with modern antiepileptic drugs. Shankhapushpi (botanically, Convolvulus Pluricaulis) is very important Medya herb (brain tonic), digestive, appetite stimulant and carminative for digestive system used in Ayurveda. Shankhpushpi is the one which helps in enhances the brain Vitality and Functions. It helps in balancing memory disturbances such as short attention span, concentration impairment, language and learning issues. A traditionally herb which to improve your child's intelligence and learning capabilities. It balances neurotransmitters and thereby improves concentration



Composition: Each 500 mg capsule contains:

Alkaloid 4% (300mg)

Shankhpushpi Powder (200mg).

Shankhpushpi powder used here is wet triturated with shankhpushpi decoction to increase the potency of the powder. This process is known as "Bhavana" in Ayurveda. Bhavana is used often in Ayurvedic formulations to increase the potency and for size reduction so that the efficacy of the product get enhanced.

**Chemical composition:** Various chemical compositions, such as glucose, sucrose, glycosides, alkaloids and various acids etc., are found in the plant. Convolvulus pluricaulis is a twining perennial herb considered as the most wonderful gift of nature to the mankind. In Ayurveda (an ancient system of Indian medicine), it is mentioned as a rasayana which is commonly used as brain stimulator and memory enhancer. Chemical studies of whole plant have shown the presence of glycosides, coumarins, flavonoids and alkaloids. Shankhpushpi, (the alkaloid) has been identified as active principle. B. sitosterol glycoside, Hydroxy Cinnamic acid, Octacosanol tetracosane along with glucose, sucrose also have been isolated from the plant drugs.

#### Ayurvedic aspect: Various Ayurvedic uses of shankhpushpi are:

Medhya – Paste of Shankhapushpi improves memory and intelligence

Rasayanam - anti aging, improves life expectancy, longevity

Kasajit - useful in cough, cold

Visha – useful in toxic conditions, natural detoxifier

Apasmara – useful in epilepsy

Unmada, Bhuta – useful in psychiatric disorders

Chardihara – useful in vomiting

Sara - promotes movement of liquids in natural path, useful in constipation

Vrushya – acts as aphrodisiac

Manasarogahrut – useful in mental disorders, depression

Smrutiprada – improves memory. Hence useful in Alzheimer's disease, dementia and in students seeking memory improvement.

Kantida - improves skin complexion and quality

Balada – improves strength

Agnida - improves digestion strength

Kushta – useful in skin diseases

Krimi – useful in intestinal worm infestation

Anidra – useful in insomnia, induces sleep

It improves hair quality and promotes hair growth

Useful in high BP and hematemesis (blood vomiting)

Because it enhances mood, relieves anxiety and and acts as aphrodisiac, it is quite useful in treating sexual disorders of men.

It has mild diuretic action. Hence used in relieving fluid retention.
